NATIONAL JUDGE ACCREDITATION PROCEDURE

To be accredited as a National judge, interested participant must fulfill the following:

- A1 Have prior or current experience in archery shooting, spanning a total period not less than 12 months in duration within the last three years (Registration through affiliates which need to certify the participant have a minimum of 12 months of archery experience).**
- A2 Attain a minimum age of 18 years, no maximum age but must be physically fit.**
- A3 Attend and pass online Training Modules (5) to achieve NJ candidate (NJc) status.**
- A4 Attend a Judge Seminar (2 X 3 hours) conducted by AAS.**
- A5 Pass the National Judges Examination (3 hours), which consists of three sections. Section A: MCQ (Close Book), Section B: Short Answer (Close Book) and Section C: Long Answer (Open book)**

The pass mark is 80% in each section.
- A6 Attend a practical session (3 hours) conducted by AAS.**
- A7 Complete 8 hours of On-the-job-training (OJT) to achieve National Judge status.**

**Any National Judge Candidate who, due to exceptional circumstances, does not achieve accreditation as a National Judge within 6 months of completing the Online Modules shall be required to apply in writing to the Chairperson of the Judges Committee for consideration of an extension.*
