Pre-Requisites

All applicants must possess the following prior to attending the SG Coach Level 1 Full Integration (Archery) Certification Program:

1. Be at least 21 years of age.
2. Have at least 3 years shooting experience with any AAS Affiliated Club.
3. Achieved the following scores (to show proof/record) in any sanctioned/recognized competition/trial, or FITA/WA Target Award, held in or after the year 2010:
 - 3.1. Double (2) rounds, 72 arrows
 - 3.1.1. Recurve 70m – FITA 500 White Star/WA Target Award White
 - 3.1.2. Compound 50m – FITA 600 Blue Star/WA Target Award Blue
 - 3.2. Single (1) Round, 36 arrows
 - 3.2.1. A minimum of 250 points at 70m for Recurve on 122cm target face
 - 3.2.2. A minimum of 260 points at 50m for Recurve on 80cm 10 rings target face
 - 3.2.3. A minimum of 300 points at 50m for Compound on 80cm 6 rings target face

Skill Test

1. In the event that the applicants do not have the archery competition score as above, a trial shoot can be conducted at AAS national range.
2. To shoot one (1) round of 36 arrows at 50m on 80cm 10 rings target face for recurve or compound on 80cm 6 rings face to achieve the above score. That is 260 for recurve and 300 for compound.
3. If applicants failed to achieve the required score, he/she will not be able to participate in the program.
4. Applicant to pay a test fee of \$30.00 for the skill test.
5. The Skill test will be conducted once per course.

Full Course Fee

1. The full Integrated SG Coach Level 1 Full Integration (Archery) Course Fee is S\$1500.00 excluding GST.
2. All course materials will be included.

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Written Test

1. Applicants who have completed the course elements with above 80% attendance on the program will have to take a written test. The test consists of multiple-choice questions and a written question on Coaching Technique, Equipment and Rules on Archery.
2. Passing mark for the test is 70%.
3. For those who failed the 1st attempt, only one retest is allowed.

Practical Assessment Competency Coaching Test (PACCT)

1. The test applies to the Technical Element.
2. In the process of teaching the shooting technique to the students, the shooting technique process can be broken up into many tasks. The trainee coach will be assigned 2 tasks to teach during this practical coaching test. They will act as coach and students and the emphasis is on delivery part of teaching the task.
3. Example of a teaching tasks can be the following:
 - 3.1. How to find the facial mark, i.e., the anchoring points.
4. The trainee coach needs to do preparation taking into consideration all the competencies items in the check list (example like "Clear Learning Objective", "Considers learners diverse needs") to conduct the teaching task. The time for the trainee coach to deliver each teaching task is 15 minutes.
5. The criteria for trainee to be competence, need to have more competencies check box checked than empty one on each process like Preparation (planning), Delivery, Management, Feedback and Evaluation. The evaluator can add comments on the Comments column.
6. The practical assessment above is evaluated by the qualified a NROC Senior coach.

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Coaching Hours Mentoring Observation

1. Upon completion of the course, each participant must complete a total of 36 hours of coaching attachment, within 6 months with an AAS affiliated clubs before he/she be awarded a full SG Coach Level 1 Full Integration (Archery) Certificate
2. For evaluation purpose, the tasks carried out by the trainee coach may be checked by the Coaching Committee on-site during the Mentoring Observation.
3. The form to be completed by applicants and signed by the relevant parties.

Others

1. Any other form of waiver and accreditation must be presented to the Coaching Committee of AAS, with valid supportive reason(s) and is subjected to approval.
2. All applicants will only be awarded with Certificates issue by AAS/SportSG. The Policy and Program do not accredit or issue any WA Coaching Certification.
